



"For we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building." – 1 Corinthians 3:9 (NIV 2011)

Paul was speaking to the Christians in Corinth who were apparently confused about their role in the kingdom of God. Old-Time Custard Ice Cream

(recipe from tasteofhome.com)

Prep Time: 55min + chilling

Process Time: 55min/batch + freezing

Yields: 2 3/4 quarts

Ingredients

- 1-1/2 cups sugar
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 cups whole milk
- 4 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 2 pints heavy whipping cream
- 3 tablespoons vanilla extract

Directions

- In a large heavy saucepan, combine sugar, flour and salt. Gradually add milk until smooth. Cook and stir over medium heat until thickened and bubbly. Reduce heat to low; cook and stir 2 minutes longer. Remove from heat.
- In a small bowl, whisk a small amount of hot mixture into eggs; return all to pan, whisking constantly. Bring to a gentle boil; cook and stir 2 minutes. Remove from heat immediately.
- Quickly transfer to a large bowl; place bowl in a pan of ice water. Stir gently and occasionally for 2 minutes.
 Press plastic wrap onto surface of custard. Refrigerate for several hours or overnight.
- Stir cream and vanilla into custard. Fill cylinder of ice cream freezer two-thirds full; freeze according to manufacturer's directions. (Refrigerate remaining mixture until ready to freeze.) Transfer ice cream to freezer containers, allowing headspace for expansion.
 Freeze 2-4 hours or until firm. Repeat with remaining ice cream mixture.
