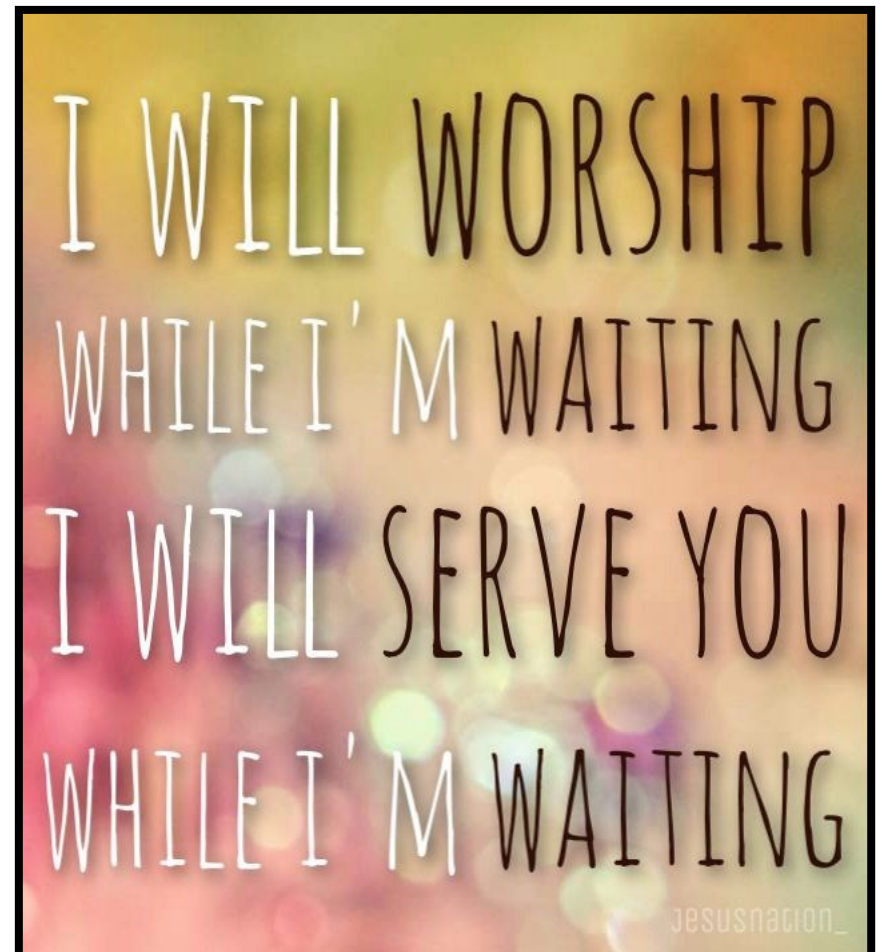



### **Kingdom Partnership...**

“For we are co-workers in God’s service; you are God’s field, God’s building.” – 1 Corinthians 3:9 (NIV 2011)

Paul was speaking to the Christians in Corinth who were apparently confused about their role in the kingdom of God. They had lost their focus on what was important and what the overall purpose was to be while they were on earth. Can you imagine that, a world where Christians were not focused on what was important? You know, things really haven’t changed in some respects. We get better, then we take a step back, then we get better...you get the idea. We just need reminders to get back on track sometimes, which is why I love that God’s word addresses so many problems that we still struggle with today; like the one in 1 Corinthians 3.

The church had focused on whose teaching they were following. A detail that should not have been the issue. What they really should have been focused upon is the fact that all pointed to the foundation of Jesus Christ. They were also getting caught up in the role that each was playing. Paul was clear to state that each had their purpose, but everything came together because of God.

Many do the same today. We worry more about the latest teaching and the role we play. When, in reality, we ought to be looking at how we can strengthen the kingdom as a whole. As 1 Corinthians 3:9 clearly states, we are “co-workers.” We **all** have a role to play. We may not have the same role, but we **do** have a role to play in God’s kingdom, of which we are **all** a part.

The “we” is obviously meant to draw each of us in as individuals here. However, I would also like to submit, that “we” would also draw us in as a church. We (the church) have a role to play among other churches, working together for the kingdom of God. FBC Hooks much do their part in order to build the kingdom with other churches. We are part of a kingdom partnership. We ought to be asking...how can we help in conjunction with other churches to advance to kingdom of God?

### **Old-Time Custard Ice Cream**

*(recipe from tasteofhome.com)*

**Prep Time:** 55min + chilling

**Process Time:** 55min/batch + freezing

**Yields:** 2 3/4 quarts

#### **Ingredients**

- 1-1/2 cups sugar
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 cups whole milk
- 4 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 2 pints heavy whipping cream
- 3 tablespoons vanilla extract

#### **Directions**

- In a large heavy saucepan, combine sugar, flour and salt. Gradually add milk until smooth. Cook and stir over medium heat until thickened and bubbly. Reduce heat to low; cook and stir 2 minutes longer. Remove from heat.
- In a small bowl, whisk a small amount of hot mixture into eggs; return all to pan, whisking constantly. Bring to a gentle boil; cook and stir 2 minutes. Remove from heat immediately.
- Quickly transfer to a large bowl; place bowl in a pan of ice water. Stir gently and occasionally for 2 minutes. Press plastic wrap onto surface of custard. Refrigerate for several hours or overnight.
- Stir cream and vanilla into custard. Fill cylinder of ice cream freezer two-thirds full; freeze according to manufacturer's directions. (Refrigerate remaining mixture until ready to freeze.) Transfer ice cream to freezer containers, allowing headspace for expansion. Freeze 2-4 hours or until firm. Repeat with remaining ice cream mixture.
