
## SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER April 22 & April 23, 2017

Beginning Sunday, April 23rd [today], Jonathan Guse and Joshua Mugg will be teaching a class on world religions. They will discuss: Judaisim, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Naturalism, Mormonism, and Jehovah's Witness, focusing on how they answer the big questions of life (why are we here? what happens when we die? how should we act?). They will also discuss how to evangelize people of other faiths. This class meets in Mission Hall.

#### SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS

Preschool - 4th Grade: On the first Easter, Mary Magdalene and His disciples discover "The Empty Tomb" (John 20:1-18). In Sunday School today, the children learned how Jesus comes to us in His Word, so that the Spirit gives us faith to believe in Christ's resurrection and comforts us when we mourn the death of loved ones. You might discuss, "How did Jesus' followers react when they discovered the empty tomb? How can we share the message of the resurrection?"

Preschool and Kindergarten students meet in the RLS kindergarten classroom, and 1st-4th grade students meet in the RLS 4th grade classroom.

5<sup>th</sup> grade - 7<sup>th</sup> grade: Today the students will be discussing Galations 1:10 - "Who I Am Not", using the curriculum, "God's Big Story". These students meet in the RLS 5th/6th grade classroom.

8th grade confirmation: Eighth graders continue to prepare for Confirmation, meeting in the 7th/8th grade RLS classroom.

# ST. PETER LUTHERAN CHURCH, HUNTINGTON, IN Portraits of Christ in the Book of Revelation - Saturday, May 13, 2017

On **Saturday, May 13, 2017**, you are invited to St. Peter Lutheran Church, Huntington, for a special presentation by **Dr**. **Charles Gieschen** (to be held in the Education Building, with entrances off of John or Polk Street). This time of studying the Scriptures with Dr. Gieschen will examine the various portrayals of Christ in the book of Revelation in order to appreciate how they teach about who Jesus is and what He has done, is doing, and will do on the final day. The significance of these portrayals of Christ as the Glorious Man and the Slaughtered Lamb for the seven congregations as well as the church today will be discussed. Dr. Gieschen serves as Academic Dean and Professor of Exegetical Theology at Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne. He has done extensive study and teaching on this topic for over 30 years and has
