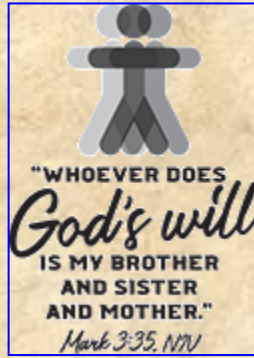


**THE 3<sup>RD</sup> SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST**
