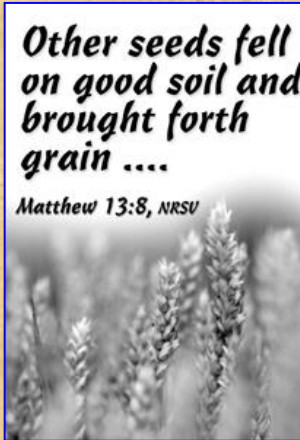


SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST
