We are celebrating the end of the first quarter. What a time it has been! Enrollment was upenrollment dropped - and now we are growing again. We are starting the second quarter with 128 students. In a few weeks, we will begin a new campaign to recruit students for the Watch for the Facebook ads and forward them to people you know. second semester. Financially we are still seeking donors for both of the scholarship programs. We are about \$2000 short of the amount we need for the RLS scholarships for the youngest of our students.
