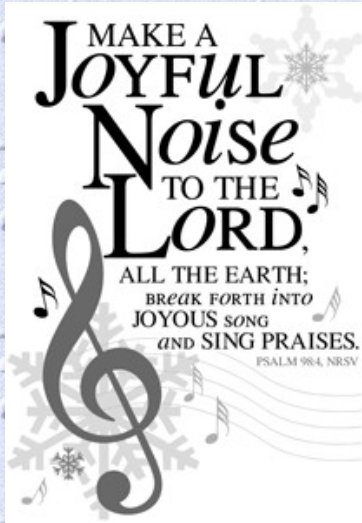


CELEBRATION OF ALL SAINT'S DAY - MUSIC FEST WEEKEND

OUR REDEEMER'S CHURCH LIBRARY FEATURED BOOKS IN NOVEMBER!

The Strength You Need by Robert J. Morgan. After reviewing 232 occurrences of the word strength in Scripture, Pastor Robert Morgan chose to concentrate on twelve clear passages that drop anchor in God's Sea of Strength. The result was one of total transformation, both for him and for his disabled wife. Combining page-turning stories with scriptural truths, Morgan explores important areas, such as: Lifelong Strength, Imparted Strength, Tranquil Strength, and Innermost Strength.
