CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION





EPISTLE READING: ROMANS 10:9-15







DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

We believe that in the Lord's Supper we receive the body and blood of Jesus in, with, and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins and the strengthening of our faith. In preparation for this sacrament, you are encouraged to read and answer the following questions:

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE PARTAKING OF THE HOLY COMMUNION:

- 1. Am I a sinner in need of forgiveness?
- 2. Do I believe forgiveness comes only through Jesus, who is my Savior?
- 3. Do I believe Jesus' Body and Blood are present and given in this meal?
 - 4. Do I want to repent of my sins and live my life more for Jesus?
