The region of Tabgha sits along the western shore on the northern edge of the sea of Galilee. In this one small area, Jesus traveled often, and many Biblical events took place here.

These include:

- · The Calling of the first Apostles (Mark 1:16-20)
- · The Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5)
- · The Healing of the Leper (Matthew 8:1-4)
- The Feeding of the Multitude (Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:30-44)
- · Jesus Walks on the Water (Mark 6:45-52)
- Jesus meets Peter and his companions after the Resurrection (John 21)
- · Jesus' last appearance in Galilee (Matthew 28:16-20)

We visited the Church of the Multiplication in Tabgha. Construction barriers highly restricted our access to the area, and we were not allowed to walk along the shoreline at all on this stop. However, we were able to visit the Byzantine chapel. Here we saw the famous mosaic of loaves and fishes on the floor in front of the altar. The paten and chalice I brought home contain a replica of this mosaic.

The air was heavy with the humidity here. We noticed a distinct change in the landscape as we traveled north. Olive groves, vineyards, and fruit farms replaced the sand and rocks of the desert. The level places gave way to hills with dark stones jutting out of them. The types of caves shepherds used to protect their sheep peeked out alongside the hills. It was easy to imagine Jesus preaching on these hillsides.

In this remote little place, Jesus met ordinary fishermen, lepers, and hungry people. Crowds followed him, and he had pity on them and met their needs. He grew weary here and needed to go away for prayer and rest. His love and compassion compelled him to work miracles here. While this was not his home, he returned here often, and on this shore, he met Peter after the resurrection.
