A message from Randy Adams, Executive Director.

Dear Pastor,

I hope this finds you well and off to a good start in the New Year! In this update I have two primary reminders and pieces of information. One concerns a training opportunity for your small group leaders and mentors. The other is our next big Asia mission trip in which we will serve our missionaries and their children. We need about 130 volunteers for that trip. The information for each event is contained below or in the attachments.

Also, I'm sending a video that you can show to your church, should you choose, encouraging participation in the Asia mission trip. On our first big trip it took people from 32 churches to get enough volunteers. Some churches will send groups, but many churches will have one or two go. So, even if you have 30 on Sunday morning, think of the one, two or three that might be good on a trip like this, and to whom a trip like this would appeal to. One of the great things about our East Asia partnerships is that it enables small churches, and one person, to be a part of something big.
