Brothers and Sisters,

The Oregon Mission Coalition was founded to strengthen the existing Churches of Region 4 and help establish new Churches by supporting and encouraging one another in reaching our communities for Christ. There are several mission opportunities this Summer for a team from your church to help in a local neighborhood outreach or evangelistic event. These are one day "mission trips" Starting at 9:30am and ending by 2pm. All it costs is \$5 for lunch. Materials and training will be provided for each outreach, all that's needed is a willing heart.
