Board to consider NWBC executive director nominee

Randy Adams and his wife, Paula, will be in the Northwest Feb.17-25 to visit the area and meet with NWBC staff members while being considered by the NWBC executive board.

VANCOUVER -- "The Northwest Baptist Convention executive board will convene Feb. 21 for a called meeting to consider recommending Randy Adams, leader of the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma's church outreach team since 2004, as the convention's next executive director.

Adams, 51, is the unanimous choice of a search committee appointed last summer by NWBC president Steve Schenewerk. Adams must be approved by the board when it gathers at the Northwest Baptist Center in Vancouver, WA, and elected by convention messengers at a subsequent special called meeting before succeeding Bill Crews, who is retiring.

"We are pleased and excited to present Dr. Randall Adams as the committee's recommendation to be the next executive director of the NWBC," said Clint Ashley, search committee chairman. "We recognize in him the spiritual giftedness and ministry experience to lead us in our cooperative efforts in reaching people who need to know Christ, and in planting new congregations throughout the Northwest."

He and his wife, the former Paula Ketchum of Bakersfield, CA, married at the end of 1981. They have two sons attending Oklahoma Baptist University.

Jeff Iorg, president of Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary and former NWBC executive director, was among those who recommended Adams to the search committee. Among Iorg's statement in a letter to the committee:

"He is a strong leader with an intentional commitment to fulfilling the Great Commission. He is also a personable leader with a proven ability to build relationships and facilitate cooperative ministry partnerships. ... he has a missional approach to ministry and life. ... He will bring a fresh perspective – new eyes to look at the challenges in your region – but with a patience and humility you will find winsome."

In addition to Ashley, the search committee included Barry Campbell, pastor of Highland Baptist Church, Redmond, OR; Ben Davis, pastor of Hope Fellowship, Maple Valley, WA; Leslie Toll, a member of Smith Rock Community Church, Terrebonne, OR; and Jamie Sims, a member of First Baptist Church, Beaverton OR. Serving on the committee ex officio are Schenewerk, pastor of Community Baptist Church, Winston, OR, and Crews.

Adams expressed appreciation to Northwest Baptists "for their prayers for us during the search process," citing Proverbs 3:5-7 as defining "the spirit of the search: trusting in the Lord, acknowledging him, and gladly allowing him to direct our steps in the search. God has faithfully done just that." "
