Many of you may already be aware that Sara Wisdom went to be with the Lord yesterday morning, April 22, 2013, in the early morning hours after a long difficult battle with breast cancer. Sara served the Northwest Baptist Convention as WMU Director beginning in June 1972 until her retirement as Women's Missions Strategist in March 2005. She was 74 years old.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, May 10, at First Baptist Church, 5755 SW Erickson Ave., Beaverton, Oregon 97005, at 2:00pm.

Sara is survived by her brother and sister-in-law Jack and Sherry Wisdom, and her nephew Jace and his wife. Jacks and Sherry's address is 17200 Panorama Dr., Dripping Springs, Texas 78620.
