Opportunities abound in East Asia partnership

Northwest Baptists have been invited to serve International Mission Board personnel and their families serving the East Asia and the Deaf affinities, according to Steve Ellis, the IMB's director for East Asia workers.

An affinity-wide meeting followed by training for IMB personnel is slated for Pattaya, Thailand, August 1-10, 2016 and up to 200 volunteers from the Northwest are needed to support the meeting and provide quality sessions for over 1,300 participants.

Childcare workers will be needed for babies, one-year-olds and preschoolers and age graded leadership are necessary for sessions with elementary, middle and high school students that will total over 550.

"I am more than excited that up to 200 of our folks from throughout the Pacific Northwest will get the blessing of serving our missionaries," said Randy Adams, executive director for the Northwest Baptist Convention. "I appreciate the invitation to serve our overseas personnel in this way."

Adams and IMB president David Platt will speak at the conference.

A hospitality team will be formed to meet personal needs for participants and may include such varied ministries as hair stylists, medical services and pastoral or clinical care for those serving daily on the front lines of mission service.

Northwest Baptist churches are asked to consider "adopting" a specific age group for the conference so consistent training can occur easily. A background check and valid passport will be a necessity for all mission trip volunteers.
