Greetings dear friends!

As many of you know, I was born in southern Indiana, and my parents' families were all living there as well. And we were all raised in the church, but not the Lutheran Church. It was called the Central Christian Church. And one of my lasting memories was the day that my aunt Peggy, who was 16 at the time, was baptized in one of the local rivers. It was a beautiful Sunday morning and there was quite a crowd that had gathered for this celebration. And even though there was a crowd of church folks, and I wasn't able to be real close to Peggy as she was being "dunked" in the water, I could clearly hear every word that the minister was speaking to her and to the community. But these are the words that I still remember specifically: "Peggy, you belong to God." And I still remember Peggy telling me the next day that she could still feel the cross on her forehead.

I think I was about 7 yrs. old then, and I didn't have a clue what she was talking about, but I remember looking for that cross on her forehead. Peggy belonged to God, and nothing could ever change that. Nothing! And now, whenever I baptize babies, or children, or adults, I make it a point to remind them or their parents, that WE ALL belong to God.

We don't belong to our boss at work. We don't belong to an abusive spouse, or to any of our addictions. We are not defined by our disabilities or sickness, our successes or failures. We don't belong to the advertising industry that depends upon our money. And yes, we don't belong to any political party. Even though it may feel like it, when we are gathered for a meal, or for a card game, or a cold beverage, and we end up being drawn into a never-ending and hurtful political argument. Yes, even though it might feel like, look like, smell like, or hurt like you belong to a political party....YOU DO NOT!

YOU BELONG TO GOD!!

No one determines our worth in this world, or in the next world, other than God. The Bible teaches us that "God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28.


ALL THINGS! Even pandemics, even political elections! Our task, dear friends, OUR call, is to seek the will
