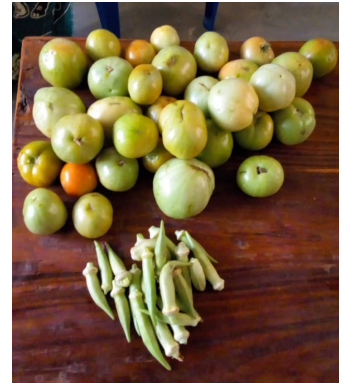

Ashley has been working with villagers setting up perma-gardens which is the picture on the left. The villagers usually send her home with peanuts, but surprised her this week with green tomatoes and okra (picture on right) which she fried up and enjoyed.



Perma-gardening is a technique that integrates water-saving methods, companion planting, and organic soil fertility practices to mimic a self-sustaining ecosystem within a small area, allowing high yields of nutrient-dense, seasonal fruits and vegetables to be available year-round
