Ideas for Gifting the Church. Looking beyond strictly cash donations, many people make donations od securities, usually stocks or bonds. There are several advantages to the donor for this type of gift (not paying capital gains tax) and of course, there is a significant value to the Church in receiving the gift. Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows IRA holders, age 70-1/2 or older to donate to a Church (or other Charities) from their traditional or Roth IRA (including inherited) tax-free.

The mechanics of gifting to the Church with appreciated securities (stocks, bonds and mutual funds) would be to have your financial services company (broker) transfer the securities to a Church account in-kind. The Church would then sell the securities in their account to generate cash. A capital gain would be created, however, the Church would not owe taxes because of it's tax status. To do a transfer, contact the Church Treasurer or the church office.
