



Riverview Alliance Awana Club's Parent Information

We're glad your child is part of our Awana Program this year. We would like to extend an invitation to you to stay and get to know your child's leader(s) at any time during the club year. Also, we welcome your questions or comments about our program. Please direct them to our Church Office at (920) 846-8303. The items below are important to the operation of our Awana Clubs.

WEEKLY DUES: Money received is used to fund the Awana program. Dues are \$1.00 per week per child, maximum \$3.00 per week per family.

You may pay dues in advance, however adjustments will not be made in the event of a child's absence or club cancellation due to weather.

- ⇒ Annual dues are one child-\$20.00, family-\$60.00.
- ⇒ ½-year dues are one child-\$10.00, family-\$30.00.

CHILD DROP OFF: 6:15 - 6:30 pm

Parents, please drop your children off in a timely manner. We cannot be responsible for your child(ren) before our doors open at 6:15 pm. Our Awana Club night will begin at 6:30 pm. All children are expected to be on the circle promptly at 6:30 pm for the start of club.

CHILD PICK UP/DEPARTURE:

Parents, please plan to join your child(ren) in the basement at 7:55 pm each week for awards, announcements and closing prayer. If you choose not to come for our closing session, we kindly request that you arrive by 8:00 pm when Club is dismissed. Your child(ren) will be waiting for you in the basement. For safety reasons, children are NOT permitted to go outside after Club without an adult. This is especially important in the winter because of the early darkness, snow and ice.

ENTRANCE BOOKLET/HANDBOOK:

The first time a child attends Awana, he or she is given an Entrance Booklet. Over the next few weeks, sections in the booklet are to be worked on and memorized at home, and then recited to a Leader during Club. Sections MUST be recited in order (i.e. 1-2-3) – no skipping around. After the booklet is completed, the child is eligible to purchase a uniform and a handbook (see cost sheet).

RULES OF CONDUCT:

Our Club rules of conduct are very important for discipline and for the safety of all. Please take them seriously. Read them together with your child(ren).

1. NO FIGHTING (or hitting or pushing others).
2. NO SWEARING OR NAME CALLING.
3. SHOW RESPECT TO ALL LEADERS.
4. SHOW RESPECT FOR THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS AND THE CHURCH.
5. DO NOT BE DISRUPTIVE.
6. DRINKS AND BATHROOM BREAKS ONLY BEFORE OR AFTER CLUB, OR DURING INTERMISSIONS.
7. CHILDREN ARE TO REMAIN INSIDE THE BUILDING AT ALL TIMES, UNLESS SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT.
8. NO RUNNING UNLESS INVOLVED IN A GAME THAT REQUIRES RUNNING.

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE:

1. VERBAL WARNING FROM THE LEADER.
2. PARENT IS CONTACTED CONCERNING THE OFFENSE.
3. SUSPENSION FROM CLUB FOR ONE WEEK.
