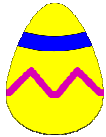
**Student Ministry**

Easter is almost here and I pray you are excited about celebrating the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior. We will again do The Big Invite. We are mailing 5000 postcards inviting people to experience the hope we have in Jesus on Easter Sunday. The next two Sunday afternoons (March 18th & 25th) we will be going out in teams to invite our community to come and worship with us on Easter. Please come and be a part of the cooperative effort to engage our community by showing that we care about them. So many people have no hope in their lives and we know the hope they can have in Jesus. We will have people to keep the children while the adults and youth go out on the Big Invite, including children's choir practice on these afternoons from 4-6 PM.

Our Easter Services will be as follows: **Children's Easter Egg Hunt** Saturday, March 31st 10—noon. Lunch will be provided, please bring a dozen plastic eggs.

**SonRise** 7 AM with breakfast to follow in the fellowship hall, (please bring your favorite breakfast casserole, church will furnish sausage, biscuits and grits).

**Sunday School:** 9:30 AM and **Easter Worship** at 10:30 AM. Invite all your friends and neighbors to attend with you!

The church has called William Hurst to serve as youth minister and he will begin his ministry on Easter Sunday, April 1st. Pray for William, Lesley, Ashleigh, Will, Jacob and Henry as they move to Grady County and as William begins serving the Lord with us.
