SERMON OUTLINE

From the Glory of the Transfiguration to the Glory of the Cross

Matthew 17:1-9

- I. The disciples were building tents—all for glory, not for a cross (vv 1–4).
- II. The disciples fell on their faces, afraid—glory without a cross will do that to you (vv 5–6).
- III. The disciples were standing with Jesus, unafraid—the true glory of the cross is approaching (vv 7–9).
