## EASTER SUNDAY, A FEAST OF VICTORY

Christ is risen! All our debts are paid! Death is no more! This is the great and comforting message of Easter. Today we rejoice that the Lamb who was slain has won the victory over death and the devil. By His resurrection, He has truly swallowed up death forever (Isaiah 25:6–9). No more do we need to fear death. For through our Baptism into Christ, we have died with Christ and believe that we will also live with Him, as Scripture has promised (Romans 6:5–9). Today we also rejoice and give thanks to God that He has prepared a celebratory feast of “rich food” for all people in the salutary gift of the Lord’s Supper (Isaiah 25:6). It is truly a “feast of victory” for all those who share in His death and resurrection by Holy Baptism, as Martin Luther’s great Easter hymn reminds us: “Then let us feast this Easter Day On Christ the bread of heaven; The Word of grace has purged away The old and evil leaven. Christ alone our souls will feed; He is our meat and drink indeed; Faith lives upon no other! Alleluia!” (*LSB* 458:7)
