Texas Partners in Mission... This Sunday, April 27, Michael Fuchs from the Texas District will share with us the important partnership we have with the Texas Missions. God has blessed the Texas District with 80 new mission starts since 2004. Of the 80 new missions, 39 use English as their first language and 41 do not. Your missionaries in the Texas District are now preaching the Gospel hope of Jesus Christ in over 15 different languages and dialects in Texas, to people who represent over 35 different nationalities! Our great state is growing by over 1,300 people per day, and these people are moving from all parts of the world. God has brought the nations to us. Through our missions, over 9,000 new people are hearing the story of Jesus. *Texas Partners in Mission's goal is to encourage and support new mission starts and to expand God's kingdom in the Tx. District of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.*
