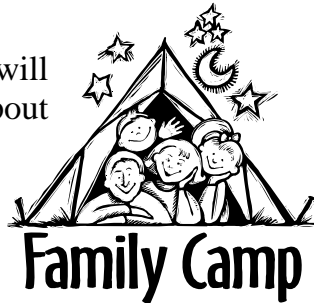
Lutheran Fellowship
