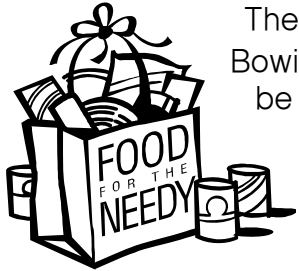
## ANNOUNCEMENTS
