Taveta Fall Trip – Nov. 8-18**

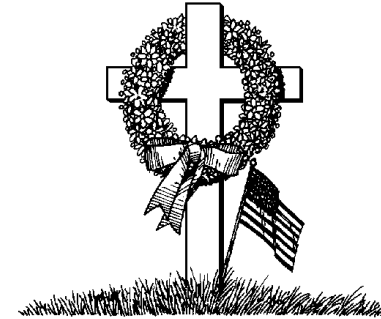
