A little about Midweek:

Midweek is a ministry designed for ages 1st-4th grade. This year, we are also considering a program for toddlers through Kindergarten. In years past it has been broken down into several sections: Lesson, Snack, Music, Recreation and Crafts. This takes place once a week on Wednesdays (alongside Confirmation classes) during the school year.

In order to reach the potential of this ministry for different age groups, we need the following volunteers:

_____ A leader (or co-leader) for Wednesday afternoons. The program will run from 3:30 - 5:30 pm. This will need to be someone who has a heart for the Lord, a love of children, and interest in leading.

_____ Assistant(s) to lead the crafts. This is a great way for someone who has a heart for the Lord and loves to dabble in "the arts". This is a great way for someone who really has a heart for the Lord, a love for children and wants to serve, but perhaps can't be there the entire time.

_____ Assistant(s) to coordinate snacks and/or playtime. This time has normally been from 3:30 - 4 p.m.
*Members have been gracious to bring snacks in the past, they only need to be set up and served to some hungry kids!
*Playtime this year may involve a little creativity. Since we do not have playground equipment set up yet, we will need someone to watch over them as they get rid of some energy before class begins.

_____ Assistant(s) to drive the church bus to pick up students from the Elementary, Intermediate and Jr. High each Wednesday afternoon. This can even be someone who picks up their child from Bowie schools anyway. (NOTE: You do not need to have a special driver's license to drive the church van.)
