## Welcome

We welcome our Mission Festival speaker, Rev. Mark Seeger, minister to the deaf.

Growing up in the Mojave Desert of California, Pastor Seeger didn't meet any deaf people until he was in his late teens. When he went to Concordia College in St. Paul, Minnesota, there was a deaf girl in his DCE class and her interpreter was the pastor from the local Lutheran deaf church. He was so mesmerized by the sign language, he asked the pastor if he could do his field work at the deaf church. This meant he had to learn sign language, which was a joy to learn. All through college and seminary, his field work was always at deaf churches. When he received his first call, it was to Alpha Lutheran Church for the Deaf in Rochester, NY, where he served for 11 years. While there, he also served the students at Rochester School for the Deaf and the college students at the National Technical Institute for the Deaf. His next call was to Jesus Lutheran Church for the Deaf in Austin, where he also served the deaf students from Texas School for the Deaf. Although technically retired, he continues to serve at Holy 3-in-1 Lutheran Church for the Deaf in Houston and with Deaf Youth Ministry of Texas, located in Austin. Deaf youth ministry has always been his passion and every year 200 to 300 students attend his deaf youth ministry. He plans to continue serving deaf youth as long as he is physically able to do so.

That deaf girl, Carol, who he met in the DCE class became his wife and they have been married for 40 years. They have two adult children, Rachel and Jonathan.
