Albright's Missional Outreach

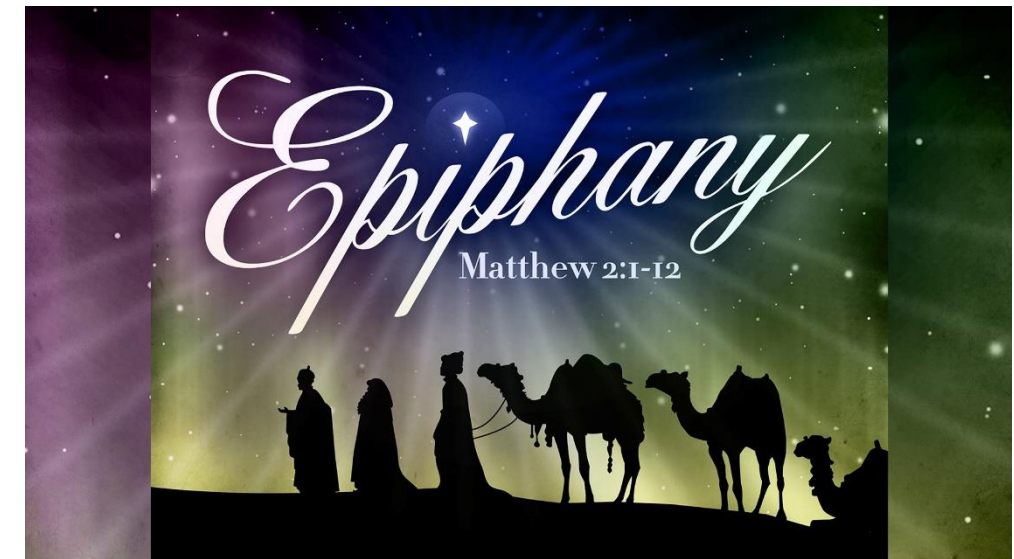
Food Drive NERA – We collect food items and donate them monthly to the New Emergency Resource Agency. In January we are collecting peanut butter.
