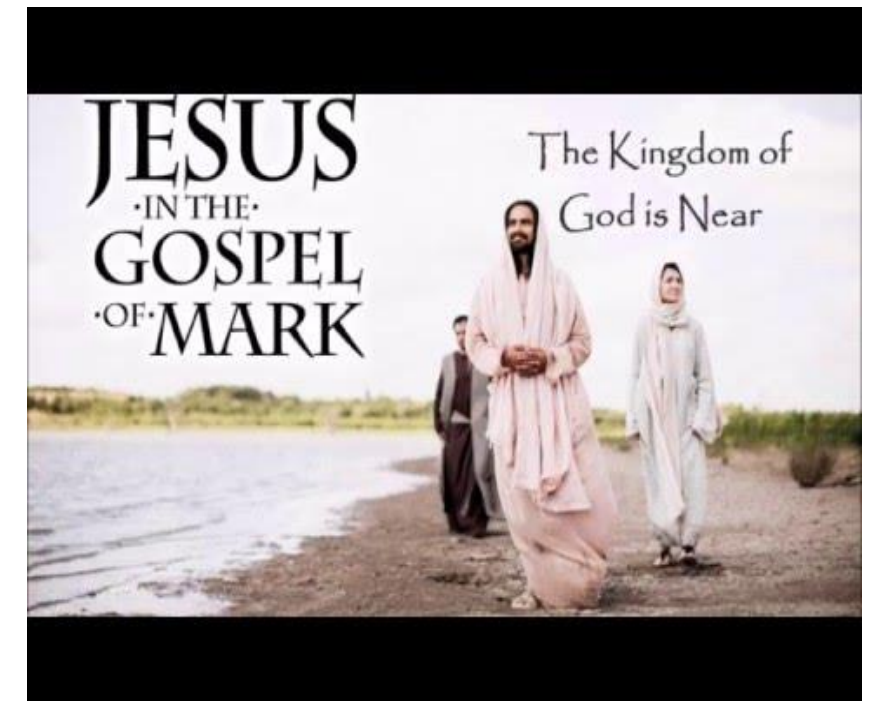
Albright's Missional Outreach
