### Albright's Missional Outreach

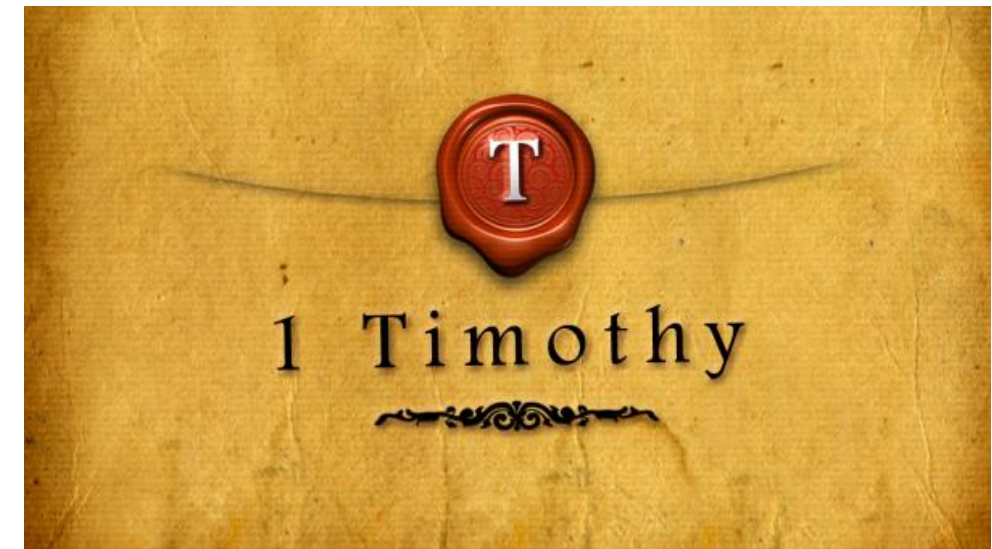
**Food Drive NERA** – We collect food items and donate them monthly to the New Emergency Resource Agency. In August we are collecting canned vegetables.
