## Rules in the Rock Series

**A Study of the Ten Commandments—Week Three**  
**The Introduction to the Law—Part Two**  
**Exodus 20:1-2**

This passage reveals three factors that should motivate us to obey the commands God gives in His Word. Last week, we discovered and discussed the first of these three factors...

I. A personal UNDERSTANDING of God (v.2a)

This morning, we're going to discover and discuss the other two factors in this passage that should motivate us to obey the commands God gives in His Word...

II. A personal \_\_\_\_\_ with God (v. 2b)

III. A personal \_\_\_\_\_ of ourselves (v .2c)

This morning, have a clear understanding of who God is, what He's done on your behalf, and from where He has brought you in Christ. Realize that if you're in Christ, God has rescued you from bondage and given you freedom. He has freed you from your sin and given you a new life. And He expects you to live that new life in obedience to His Word. Therefore, I challenge you to commit yourself to a life of faithfulness and obedience to God. Allow your understanding of God, your experience with God, and your reflection of yourself to motivate you to obey God's commands. Only you can make the decision to live in obedience to God and His Word, and I hope you will do so this morning. Trust Christ as Lord today.
