Rules in the Rock Series

A Study of the Ten Commandments—Week Four
The Institution of the Law—Part One
Exodus 20:3

This morning, we're going to begin our examination of the Ten Commandments by discussing the first commandment...

I. _____ God as the one and only true God (v.3)

This morning, understand that the triune God of the Bible is the one and only true, living God. And what's more is the fact that for those of us who have trusted Christ, He's our God. Therefore, we're to acknowledge Him as such in every aspect of our lives. We're to acknowledge Him in our speech, our conduct, our attitudes, and our thoughts. We're to adore Him, honor Him, highly esteem Him, love Him, fear Him, worship Him, rejoice in Him, delight in Him, and trust Him. We're to be zealous for Him, walking faithfully with Him, and yielding all obedience and submission to Him. All-in-all, we're to acknowledge that He's our Master, Lord, and King and glorify Him as such.

This morning, do you know the one and only true God? Have you trusted Christ as Lord of your life? Are you acknowledging God through the way you live, talk, think, and worship? Is He your all-in-all? If not, repent and return to a proper knowledge and acknowledgment of God. Submit yourself to the Lordship of Jesus Christ, who is God the Son, Savior of men, and Lord of all, and yield all obedience to Him. Acknowledge the triune God of the Bible as the one and only true God, yielding to the Father, through the Son, by the Holy Spirit.
