*A Study of the Ten Commandments – Week Ten*

*The Institution of the Law – Part Seven*

*Exodus 20:14*

*This morning, we're going to continue our examination of the Ten Commandments by discussing the seventh commandment...*

*VII. \_\_\_\_\_ your marriage promises (v.14)*

*There are two things I want to point out regarding Jesus and the seventh commandment. This week, we're going to discover the first of these two things...*

*A. How Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ the seventh commandment (Matt.5:27-30)*

*This morning, realize the seriousness of inward sin. Understand that it's not enough not to commit adultery outwardly; we must also avoid committing adultery inwardly. And we do that by submitting to the Lordship of Christ in our lives and finding our sufficiency in Him. The Lord's remedy for a wicked heart is a new heart, and His answer for our helplessness is His sufficiency. Therefore, trust Christ today and receive the new heart He desires to give you. Stop prostituting yourself out to other things and be faithful to the One who has redeemed and saved you. Keep your marriage promises, not only to your earthly spouse, but more importantly to your eternal bridegroom, Jesus Christ, realizing that doing so pleases God and brings about His blessing. Repent of your unfaithfulness this morning, both physically and spiritually, so that you can receive God's forgiveness and be restored. Then, walk in obedience to His Word and live faithfully. Keep your marriage promises and remain faithful to the covenant you've made.*
