## Key to the symbolism of the liturgical colors:

WHITE: symbolizes joy, celebration, purity

RED: symbolizes fire, blood, renewal

BLUE: symbolizes hope, anticipation, royalty

GREEN: symbolizes spiritual growth

PURPLE: symbolizes repentance

BLACK: symbolizes mourning, death
