

WORSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

August 4, 2011

Present: Pastor AJ, Paulette Johnson, Carl Steuck, Doyle Polson, Gayle Nemmers, Cindy Lerohl, Nancy Anderson, Jan Ferguson. Absent: Carla Beem, Brenda Haglin.

We met at The Phoenix Center to tour the facilities. Other committees were invited to attend the tour also. The Phoenix Center is a fairly large facility, would hold 300 people, parking space for 90 cars, limited kitchen facility (no stove, microwave only), front stage, piano, sound system. Cost would be more than at the Holiday Inn (~\$180 for 4 hours less 20% church discount), plus winter snow removal and clean-up of the facilities. Was a nice facility – we could see possibilities of using it for special events, youth events, retreat meetings, etc.

Trailer purchased for \$2525 and is working well. Next step is to have graphics made for the side of the trailer (will use our Living Word symbol). Will be completed in the next several weeks.

Reclaim hymnal feedback – we've received 25 responses so far, with a few more coming in. Opinions are being compiled, but here are the preliminary results:

1. Do we need a new hymnal? Yes: 18, No 8. Of the 8 that said no, the comments were to the effect that we do not need a new hymnal at this time but need to concentrate on the building and land purchases first. Also, no rush – wait until we get into our building.
2. Do you want the hymnal customized? Yes: 19 No: 5
3. Are there any other hymnals you prefer? Green LBW (Lutheran Book of Worship) – 3; With One Voice (WOV) – 2.
4. How do you recommend the hymnal be bound? 3-ring: 1 Spiral: 6 Hard bound: 14
5. Would you purchase one for home use? Yes: 8 No: 8
6. Would you purchase for church use? Yes: 13 No: 3
