Expenses/Bills

Expenses included \$26.49 for the confirmation cake and flower, and \$228 for the compassion child.

Catechism/Confirmation/First Communion

Pastor A.J. reported that the catechism class is being attended by three students and going well. He will continue to evaluate the schedule (meeting once a month).

The Confirmation retreat for November has been changed to February. The cost of the February retreat will be \$800 and has been put in our 2014 budget.

A parent of a confirmation student requested we move the date of Confirmation in 2014 due to a family conflict. After discussion the decision was made to keep confirmation on Reformation Sunday. If a conflict, emergency or illness arises the family should contact Pastor A.J. He will then offer them the option of having their student confirmed the Sunday after Reformation Sunday.

Sunday School is going well, we will continue with the current curriculum. The Christmas program (Catch the Christmas Spirit) will be held on December 15th.
