New Business:

- ◆ Gretchen will continue to look for round table cloths that will fit our tables. The square table cloth did not work.
- ◆ Discussed sun coming in the large windows during the church service. Doyle said a special type of shade will be put up in the next few weeks.
- ◆ Altar Plants - Any plant donated to the church should go through the Memorial Committee in which Pastor Beem is chair.
- ◆ Candles - There is a problem with the candles dripping. Gayle will explore other candles that are available.
- ◆ Kitchen "Care" - Do not bring anything for the kitchen unless the kitchen committee has agreed it is needed. Please contact the kitchen committee first! The kitchen committee is writing up a policy for all to follow when using the kitchen.
- ◆ After the church service, there is a limited number of tables and chairs available in the narthax area. We would like to make those available to those who need to sit down. There is a concern having others sitting in the cloth chairs and spilling.
- ◆ Invitation Sunday - We are not sure what the committee is planning at this time and how many will be needed to help serve and/or make cookies/treats.
- ◆ Communion Lines - Doyle is recommending 4 stations. We will need more communion servers, another helper, and 2 more baskets for the empty wine cups. Gayle will look into ordering another set of communion trays.
- ◆ Hymnals - There is a concern that there are not enough Reclaim Hymnals. We want to check with other LCMC congregations to see if they have hymnals that they are not using that we could have. It was discussed the need on communion Sundays for paper copies of the liturgy since we are short hymn books.
- ◆ Money has been given to purchase a wine cooler. Gretchen will look into purchasing one.

Gretchen closed the meeting with prayer.
