**Palm Sunday Preparations:** Palms have been ordered and will be picked up on Friday. Emerald palms will be arranged in the two gold vases for the altar.

**National Day of Prayer:** Lynne Lommen presented information about the National Day of Prayer on May 1. There will be a breakfast at the Broadway Ballroom. Tickets are \$7.50. A sign-up sheet will be available at the Information Table. Make checks payable to Unity Foundation. At noon, there will be a gathering at City Hall from 12N to 12:30 PM. LWLC will hold a time for prayer in the evening from 7-8 PM. Brochures have been ordered for our congregation and an additional 100 bookmarks will be ordered also. Information will be made available in the bulletin announcements.

**Maundy Thursday:** The platform will be used. Carpeting has been ordered but not installed at this time. Doyle will call Curt Kreklau to check the status of the carpeting. Pastor Kluver, Laurie Kluver, Doyle Polson, and MaKayla Waltzing will strip the altar at the end of the service.

**Good Friday:** Julie Savoie and Jane Haglin will provide special music. Dan Haglin will sing *Were You There?*

**Prayer Vigil on Saturday:** A prayer vigil will be held from 6 AM to 8 PM. There is a sign-up sheet at the Information Table. Pastor Kluver will provide material for use as a prayer guide.

**Easter Sunday:** There is a sign-up sheet for bringing lilies for the altar. The choir will sing. Dave Anderson and Dennis Kalpin will provide brass accompaniment. Dan Haglin will sing the 4<sup>th</sup> verse of *Were You There?* Cinnamon rolls have been ordered at Sam's Club in St. Cloud. Ten boxes of 32 rolls have been ordered. The Kluver family will provide dyed eggs for the congregation.

**Altar Guild:** Wine and grape juice has been ordered. The paraments have been on back order but should arrive next week. Mary Jo Redfield will join Gayle Nemmers and Laurie Kliver as co-coordinators.

**Music Guild:** A coordinator has not been selected. It will be done at the next meeting.

**Ushers:** The youth have done well to assist with ushering at the Lenten services. Doyle also asks them to assist on Sundays when needed. Roping off the side sections for Lenten services has been working well. There are four stations for communion and sanitizer is available at each station. Communion assistants are asked to go to a station and the trays will be brought to the serving couple. If the side sections are done, the ushers move the people from the last rows in the middle section to the side station.
