Old Business:

- Gretchen distributed the Worship Committee Annual Report for 2012 and the submitted Budget for 2013 of \$16,775 (\$10,000) for hard bound hymnals.
- Worship Committee Duties List was revised. Doyle will present this list to the Council at their next meeting for their approval.
- It was decided that the Worship Committee would develop a form to be used when requesting payment for a Supply Pastor. The Worship Committee chair would sign and give to the treasurer.

New Business:

• Lenten Services:

The youth will be serving as ushers and readers for the Lenten Services.

Special music and the pianists for the services have been established. The January 10, 2013, minutes detail the Lenten services.

- Palm Sunday Service: Paulette Johnson will pick up the palms at Anderson Florist on Saturday.

- Easter Sunday: We will have 2 assistants and 8 servers for communion. There will be 4 stations on the main floor and 2 stations upstairs for communion. There will be 5 coffee servers and each will be asked to bring trays for the rolls. Jean Johnson will order and pick up the rolls from Sam's Club for the Easter Service. The Kluver Family will provide 6 dozen dyed Easter eggs. Set up will take place at 10:00 on the Saturday before Easter for anyone who can make it.

- Worship dates at the Barn and Courtyard (Ballrooms) were discussed. However, an e-mail from the Holiday Inn management was confusing as to which dates we will be at the

Barn or in the Courtyard. Gretchen is going to set up a meeting with management to firm up where our worship services will be held. There was concern that the January 27 service may be held in the Barn according to the e-mail from the Holiday Inn. This is our annual meeting and internet wiring is needed so those not in attendance can be a part of our annual meeting. There is no internet services in the Barn. Gretchen will ask about that date as we need to be in the ballrooms for the meeting.

- Kitchen Management: Gretchen has the coffee measured and in baggies for February and March. The blue tub contains the supplies needed each Sunday. The gray tub will have the extra supplies. The gray tub and a box of more extra supplies will be stored in the trailer. Jean Johnson and Terri Elsey will check the blue tub each week to be sure supplies are refilled for the following Sunday while Gretchen is gone during February and March.

There will be no meeting in February.
