Meeting opened with devotions and prayer by Gretchen Nelson

New Business: Calendar of services for Jan., Feb., March is not confirmed at this time with the Holiday Inn. The next Sunday in the Barn is January 20, 2013.

Lenten services will be a Series: Lamb of God, Pure and Holy. Special banner relating to Lamb of God will be used to enhance worship.

Ash Wednesday service: Location is currently not confirmed. Pastor AJ has the ashes. Pianist will be Bev Stueck and special music by the Chordsmen. Communion supplies are prepared. The youth will be reading scripture and ushering. Tables for receiving empty communion cups will be needed.

Lenten services will all be held at 7pm. Ash Wednesday and Maundy Thursday services will require 2 platforms. Good Friday will require 1 platform. Simple bulletin style will be used during Lent.

Maundy Thursday: Location will be confirmed. Full platform with large round table will accomodate the youth receiving first communion and washing of their feet. Nancy Anderson is pianist. The congregation will also be receiving communion. Youth will continue ushering.

Good Friday: Location will be confirmed. One platform will be used. No Altar used. There will be stripping of table.

Palm Sunday: Location will be confirmed. Palms will be ordered from Anderson Florist. 12 emerald palms for 2 gold altar vases. Liners may be taken earlier to florist. 120 econo palms are needed for distribution to congregants. Bev Stueck is pianist.

Easter Sunday: Services will be held in the Barn. 300-350 chairs are requested. It is also requested that the Holiday Inn staff will have it set up by 9:30 on Saturday. Angie Gunderson is pianist. Several special music selections are planned. Dan Haglin will sing I Am Redeemed. Praise band will be accompanied by trumpet and trombone.

Two stations on main floor and 2 stations upstairs for communion are needed. Extra servers, and assistants will facilitate communion.

The Kluver family will provide 6 dozen dyed Easter eggs. Cinnamon rolls, approximately 140 or other rolls will be provided. Petes County Market and Eldens bakeries will be contacted for confirmation of rolls. 2 large coffee pots and 1 small pot will be used for refreshment. 18 tables and table clothes are needed (6 round and 12 rectangle).

Setup for Easter will be at 10:00am on Saturday.

Old Business: Gretchen distributed annual report and budget for 2013. Altar committee budget for 2012 was \$336.59.

Notice will be put in the bulletins for people to donate flowers to enhance Easter service.

Advertisement for services is responsibility of Evangelism Committee.
