Goals for the Worship Committee for 2015

Discussion regarding changes in the liturgical setting. This was not yet accomplished from the goals set for 2015 for various reasons. The committee still wished to pursue changes. The Music Guild and members of the Worship Committee were asked to review settings 2 and 3 in the Reclaim Hymnal and report back at the November meeting for a decision.

Goals for the Worship Committee for 2016

1. Develop a new setting for liturgy.
2. Continue to expand and enhance Wednesday evening services from June 8 to August 31, 2106.
3. Involve KREW children in a choir to sing for worship services.
4. Institute a "hymn of the month" to learn new hymns.

Music Guild Report: The choir will begin on October 25 and work with those present. They may use four part hymns from the hymnal in place of choral sheet music.

There has been a good response for those who have offered a Gift of Music for the worship services when they choir is not singing.

Altar Guild Report: Expenses include gluten free wafers (\$12.99) and 2 boxes of communion cups (\$42.98). YTD expenses are \$383.36, which is below the 2015 budget.

Pastor's Report: Pastor AJ Kluver attended the LCMC conference in Texas. There were speakers as well as panel discussions. He will write a report for the newsletter.

Usher Report: Jim Nelson said that he and Doyle were appreciative of the volunteers who have been available to usher.

Veterans' Day (November 11th): Jim Nelson, Steve Ferguson, Nancy and Dave Anderson will set up a display on November 8 in honor of Veterans' Day. Items for display should be brought to the church by Friday, November 6 and they will set up on Saturday. Nancy will submit information to Paulette to be added to the bulletin
