There are 16 women participating in Women's Choir. Two pieces of music have been ordered for them. The cost of this music is \$70 and being taken out of the choir budget.

The cost of music ordered for the mixed and women's choir in 2016 is \$167. Carla and Carolyn ordered 27 pieces of music for choir to help insure that future LWLC choirs have enough music as music goes "out of print" and it is illegal to copy printed music.

Choir is scheduled to sing through June.

Nancy and Carolyn recommend "A New Commandment" from With One Voice as the Hymn of the Month for June.

Carolyn suggested we use the With One Voice for summer worship on Wednesdays.
