**THE TENEBRAE** (“The word “Tenebrae” is Latin for shadows. We follow this ancient practice of extinguishing candles in order to feel, in a very small way, what Jesus felt as he was betrayed and abandoned by those He loved. This helps us to better appreciate the costliness of our salvation and the amazing depth of God’s love for us, that God would choose to suffer so much for our sake. When the last candle is extinguished, we realize the darkness of the world without Christ and resolve to reflect His light into the world)
