Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Big day today!! We are celebrating the work of God in so many ways this morning and this evening. The baptism of all children and adults must be so pleasing to God. Another member of the family is welcomed into the fold. Luke Streiff has been in worship almost since he was born and today, we, his church family, join his biological family and friends in the celebration of his baptism.

This evening we will gather all those who are interested in going on our third work mission to come together at 6:00pm to decide the direction we will be going and what kind of mission we will be doing. We will be welcoming others from around the Western Reserve District to join our team so that we can do the most work possible for the people in need wherever we go! All who are interested please come to the meeting. Youth must be 12 or out of the 6th grade. Adults can be any age! (I have taken 94 year olds before!!)

Now a little more about the "Neighborhoods." You will notice the colored ribbon on the ends of the pews. Each color is one "Neighborhood." On one of the pews in each colored area are clipboards with storage inside. A list of regular attendees will be made and placed on the front (one list for 8:30 and another for 10:00.) Inside the clipboard will be visitor information cards, get well cards, we miss you cards, envelopes, and pens. Each "Neighborhood" must have a captain and a co-captain from different families. These persons will be in charge of making sure the names are checked off for regular attenders and the cards are handled. They do not have to write the cards, but they need to initiate the process.

My prayer is that we all become more aware of those around us, get to know each other a bit better, care for those who are ill or absent, and become better greeters of our visitors. We will begin the work of the "Neighborhoods" next week. So if someone from each area could volunteer to be a captain and a co-captain, that would be wonderful. Instructions will be on the clipboards next week.

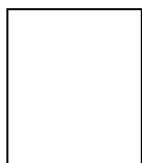
