*Call to Worship

Leader: King David wrote, "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want..." The only peace David found was a stable relationship with the God who was his shepherd.

People: Even though he walked in the valley of the shadow of death he feared no evil. There was peace for David because God was his shepherd.

Leader: The prophet Isaiah said, "Comfort, O comfort my people, says your God...A voice cries out 'In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord, make straight a highway for our God.' The peace for the people of Israel comes from a stable relationship with the God who would shepherd them.

People: "He will feed his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms and carry them in his bosom, and gently lead the mother sheep." And there was peace in the land of Israel.

Leader: Before the birth of Jesus, the world was once again in chaos. Politically, socially, and spiritually. But the angels came to the shepherds proclaiming, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors." The peace of Christ was first known by the shepherds who ran to the stable to build a relationship with the God who brought forth peace.

People: "The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told to them." Peace was upon them and praise filled their hearts. Let us find peace in the God who shepherds us.
