Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

This is Epiphany Sunday, the celebration of the Wise Men and their gift giving to **Jesus**. **For several years this has also been "White Gift Sunday" celebrating a story of villagers bringing their gifts to their king.** I have decided to emphasize the idea of **"The Journey" in a preaching series for the Epiphany Season which begins today and goes through February 11th.**
