"The Journey: What We Hear Along the Way"

Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

Transfiguration Sunday is one of those Sundays when people hear the story and think, this sounds familiar, but what does it mean! The transfiguration refers to the transition that takes place in the visual countenance of Jesus when he is encountered by God and visited by Moses and Elijah. But it is also the time when he makes a conversion from teacher and counselor to his task of being the sacrificial lamb for the sins of the world.

The voice from the cloud says something similar to what was said at Jesus' baptism, but that voice was heard only by Jesus and was an affirmation of who Jesus was and that God was pleased with him. That was at the beginning of his ministry, now that very same voice speaks the same words, but adds, "Listen to him!"; This being said toward the end of his ministry.

What is the message? What is it that we need to hear now, that we did not need to hear in the beginning? Or, did we just not listen before and now, as his time on earth draws near an end, do we need to start listening. The fact that the voice from the cloud, the voice of God, calls for us to listen gives even more authority to what Jesus has been teaching for three years. We need to start paying attention, we need to start putting other things aside, we need to start quieting the other noises in our lives and LISTEN TO HIM!

Is that clear enough for you?? It is for me!!
