Dear Friends and Friends I have not yet met,

This is the season of Lent. Each Sunday we will be taking a small portion of **Jesus' Sermon on the Mount from the Gospel of Matthew** and use it to illustrate how Jesus would have us live as we humbly follow him. Each week Jesus gives us two sides of one issue, what he would like us to do and what he would not. Let us strive to follow his words and do what he would like us to do.

Each week we will use the same Call to Worship, but will increase the lines shared by the people until, on Palm Sunday, we will be reading the entire piece together. The Call to Worship is taken from a paper found in the belongings of a young man who was martyred for his faith in Zimbabwe. The words are powerful and show the commitment this young man had toward Jesus and his ministry. We are fortunate to live in a place where we **need not fear being a Christian and working to see Christ's message is relayed to those** around us either by word or deed. But, as we read the message of this young witness who died for his belief, I pray we feel the power of these words and use them to motivate us to be more like Jesus in all that we do and say.

I would encourage you to take the bulletin home this week and commit yourself to reading this witness each morning before you start your day. It just may make a difference in how you live out your faith.
