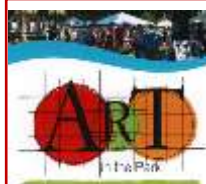
Saturday, August 11, 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., come for a retreat time of fellowship at North Perry Village Hall
