Dear Painesville UMC family,

Let me first introduce myself. My name is Marvin Brown, a retired UMC pastor who served churches in East Ohio, one of which was right down the road in Chardon from 1993 to 2001. I am also excited to have been asked to participate in your church's Consecration Sunday activities as guest preacher on Sunday, September 30th.

I asked your Consecration Sunday Leadership Team if they would grant me the privilege of writing this article as an introduction to the time we will be sharing during the month of September. No one really gets excited when the church starts talking about money. The subject is one the church has to face but I don't know of anyone who just can't wait for the preacher to start talking to their congregation about money. I do, however, know people who want to hear how they can find joy in living. The truth is Jesus talked about money a lot. His point was almost always the same: if you want joy in life it will not be found in the way the world tells you it is attained. I saw a bumper sticker once that read, "the one with the most toys wins." Far too many people have trusted in the words of this bumper sticker only to discover they are not true. Joy, the fullness of life, is not discovered in the way the world teaches.

Consecration Sunday gives us a short period of time to consider how we might get a little closer to the life Jesus talks about when He says, "I have come to give you life, and to give it to you to the full" John 10:10. I hope the time we spend together will lead you to a greater depth of living.

I want to ask a favor of you. For the remainder of this month will you promise to pray with me? I promise I will pray for you and your church every day for the rest of the month. But I want you to pray with me. And, I will even give you the script. All you have to do is pray these words, sincerely, from your heart, regularly, for the rest of the month until we reach September 30th, Consecration Sunday. ***Lord, be with our church while we go through this period of time leading up to Consecration Sunday. Open our hearts to your leading and teaching. Show me and my church family how we might find the life you came to give us.*** That is all. Just those words. Let's not get too far ahead of ourselves. Let's not make any decisions ahead of time. Let's just ask God to be with us as we enter this time together knowing if his presence is among us we need not concern ourselves with anything else for the time being. I'm looking forward to being with all of you on Sunday, September 30th. Until then may the blessings of God fill you greatly!
